

## Advisory Input Process

The following document is a suggested mechanism to create a flow of information between the Oregon Workforce Alliance (OWA) Regional Workforce Investment Boards and the OWA Local Workforce Investment Board and its committees. The purpose of this mechanism is so that information, advocacy, issues and assistance can be provided in a way that accomplishes several outcomes:

- Better / more informed policy decisions;
- Greater / more well developed advocacy;
- Greater sense of connectivity; and
- Better utilization of our rural leadership network.

Issues which might be brought forward relate to the following:

- 1) Identify inhibitive Policies regarding Economic Opportunities & Job Development
- 2) Identify infrastructure needs (workforce related infrastructure such as educational opportunities, etc.)
- 3) Identify resource needs
- 4) Report on Economic /Job BIG NEWS

RWIB staff suggests calendaring dates when Regional Advisory Input would be gathered – on a bi-yearly or quarterly basis.
